### What's being offered?

- **SCVO - Third Sector Resilience Fund** (Delivered by Firstport, Social Investment Scotland and the Corra Foundation)

*Grants ranging from £5k to £100k depending on the eligibility.*

- **Charities Aid Foundation – CAF Corona virus Emergency Fund**

*Grants up to £10k for smaller charities (Income £1m or less in their last financial year) to help deliver much need support to communities – URF for core costs, staffing, volunteers costs, supplies or other critical charitable areas.*

- **Foundation Scotland – Community RRR Fund (Community Response Recovery and Resilience Fund)**

*Grants between £1k and £5k for local charities and grass roots organisations who are currently supporting some of Scotland's most affected and vulnerable people – this is specific funding under [RRR guidelines highlighted here](#) and cannot be used to support loss of income or support on going salary costs – These should be sought through SCVO funding as noted above.*
